Mrs. Borgwardt has 8 years working in the education field. Mrs. Borgwardt enjoys running and spending time with family.

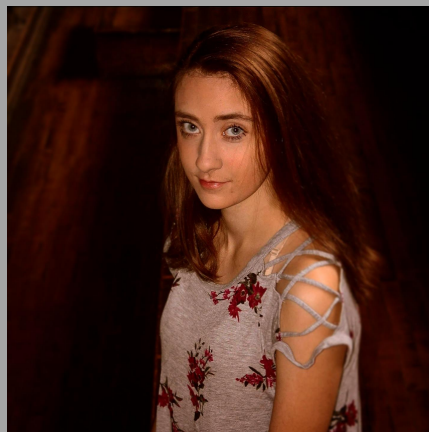
