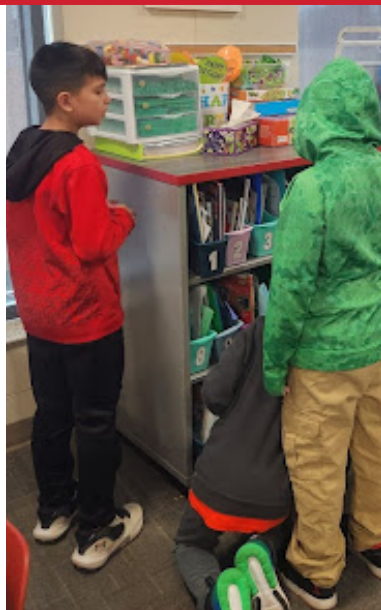
Our 4th graders wowed the audience at their recent Spring Concert! Their singing and recorder playing showed great cooperation, inspiring all to "be a light" each day!

Fourth Grade



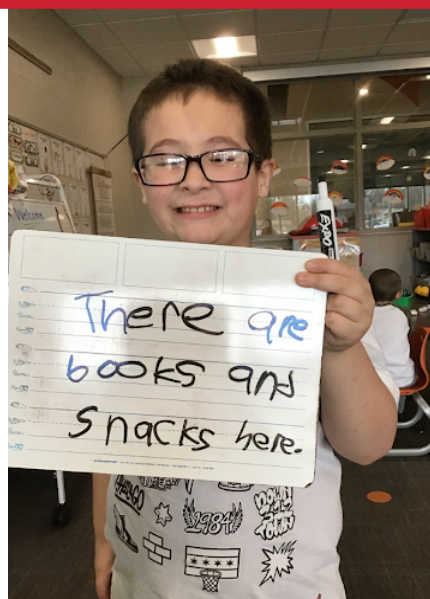
