

They <u>understand</u> the plan.




High School Needs / Goals:

- Site improvements Update track
















Tax Levy: 3 Buckets







Assumptions

Hypothetical Facilities Referendum debt is amortized with three 20-year borrowings using planning interest rates ranging from 5.25%-5.50%. Mill rate based on the 2022 Equalized Valuation (TID-OUT) of 51,637,502,110 with annual growth of 1.00% thereafter. Tertiary Aid Impact (2023-24 July 1 Estimate): 40.84%.
