

Sparta Area School District

Article 102 - Election and Membership to The Board of Education

The Board of Education shall consist of seven members.

Available expiring positions on the School Board shall be elected at the spring election for a three-year term.

The superintendent of schools will orientate the new Board of Education members including but not limited to the following:

1. Board duties and responsibilities, emphasizing District policy development.
2. Board policies.
3. The chain of command and administrative duties and responsibilities.
4. The District's curriculum development process.
5. "Open Meeting Law" regulations.
6. The District's Strategic Plan.
7. Tour District facilities.
8. Other as deemed necessary.

The elections for School Board members shall be guided by Wisconsin Statute.

In the event a vacancy occurs on the Sparta Board of Education due to health, resignation, removal from office of the incumbent, the ceasing to be a resident of the District, or other just cause as outlined by state law (except recall), the vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the remaining members according to Wisconsin Statute 17.26 and Article 103 - Board Vacancy.
