#### 1. Library Citizenship

##### Standards:

- Understand and follow library organization, procedures and policies.

##### Essential Question:

- How do we show respect and responsibility in the library with library materials? How is my library organized?

- Students will be familiar with the LMC including PBIS expectations, LMC rules, LMC teacher, and areas in the library. Students will know how to care for a library book and find books using a browsing stick.

**Essential Knowledge:**

- Students will be able to use the catalogue to locate information in the library. Students will use keyword, title and author searches.

- How do I find materials that match my interests and ability level? What are the genres and other classifications that are appropriate for me?

- Students will read award winning Caldecott books and be able to vote in the Golden Archer Award.
- Students will learn various reading strategies they can use to better comprehend text.
