In Physical Education we are learning something new; Cardio Drumming! We are working on levels, force, and rhythm while getting our heart rates up!



Mrs. Anderson's class celebrated the 100th Day of School by completing the 100th Day of School Math Challenge throughout the day.


Fourth Grade
