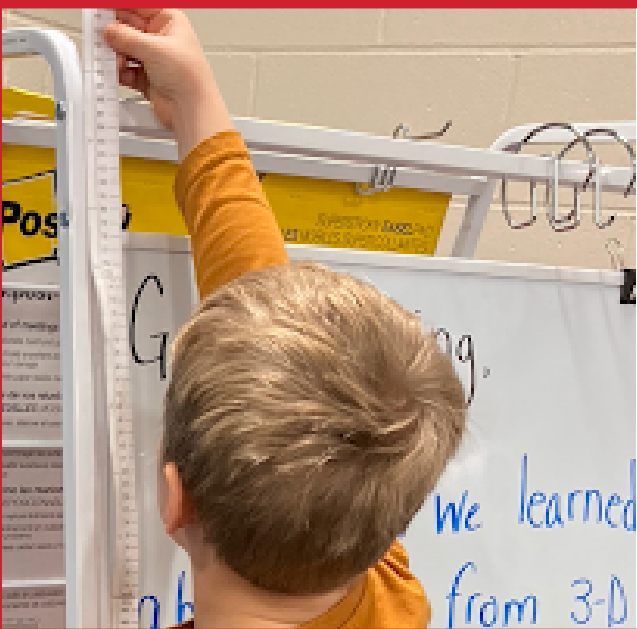
*Fourth Grade*

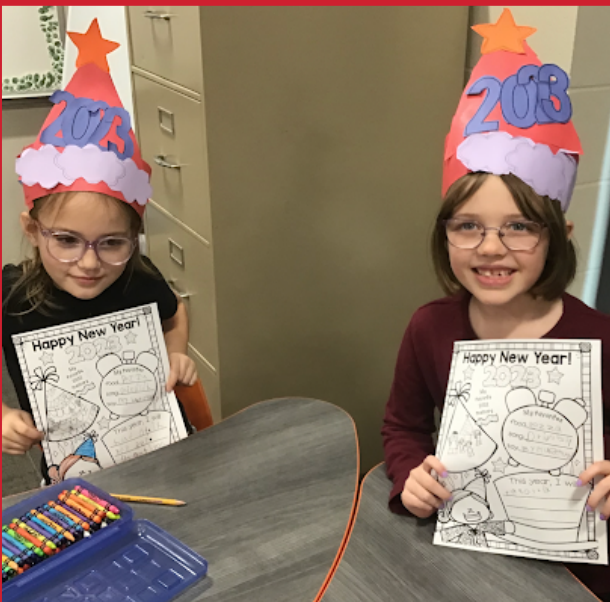
*Third Grade*



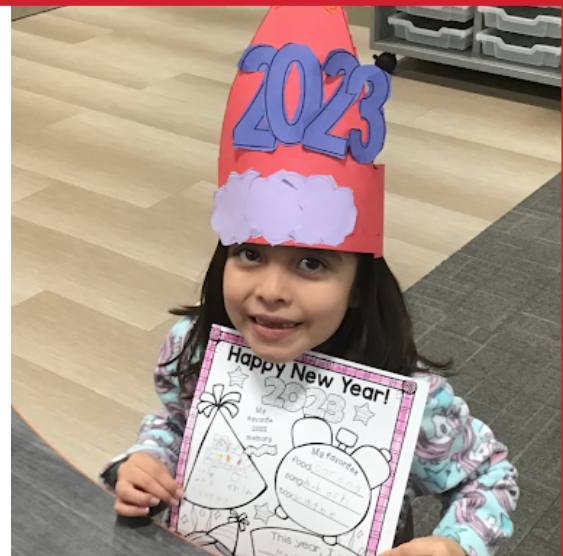
